Compliance of TVs with Energy Label and Ecodesign Requirements

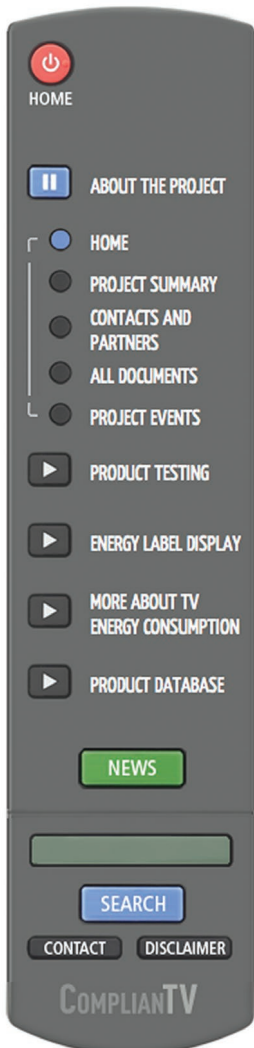

The CompliantTV project has been designed to organise large scale TV testing for the Energy Label and Ecodesign Directives compliance and retailer monitoring of the energy label display for televisions.

Ten partners from around the EU, including three testing laboratories, have teamed up to verify the compliance of TVs for the energy efficiency requirements, producer claims and to monitor the information availability at the points of sale.

We invite you to learn more about the results of the 160 TV model tests, the results of the visits of 100 physical and 100 online shops for the label display monitoring, and the overall project lessons learned and recommendations towards the proper implementation of the legislation requirements for televisions.
